

## TOWN SEAL

1. The common seal of the Town, made of metal, having engraved upon it "THE TOWN OF STELLARTON, INCORPORATED," shall continue to be the Town Seal.

2. The Seal shall be kept by the Clerk.

3. It shall be used when authorized by any statute, or by any By-Law of the Town, or by direction or resolution of the Council.

4. It shall be affixed to every agreement, contract, deed, lease, or other document to which the Town is a party, and which, in order to bind the Town required to be authenticated by a Seal.

5. The Mayor or Clerk shall affix the seal to every such agreement, contract, deed, lease or other document, which shall also be signed by the Mayor and Clerk.

6. The following form may be used when any document is to be authenticated:—

7. The Mayor or Clerk may affix the Seal to any certificate or document at the request of the person desiring it.

8. Persons requiring the Seal to authenticate documents shall pay to the Town of Stellarton the fee of One Dollar and Twenty-five cents.
